- Living in England



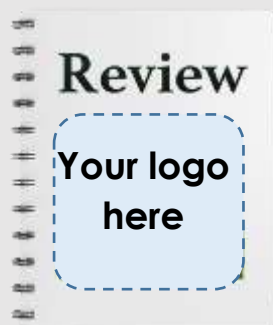
### How to send us your art

### Prize

- 5 runners-up will get **£20**
