They should be interested in:

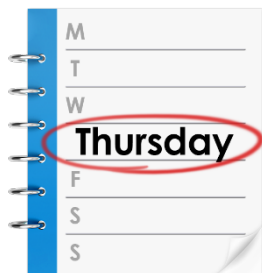
- finding out answers to questions
